May I see your all conquering power at work.

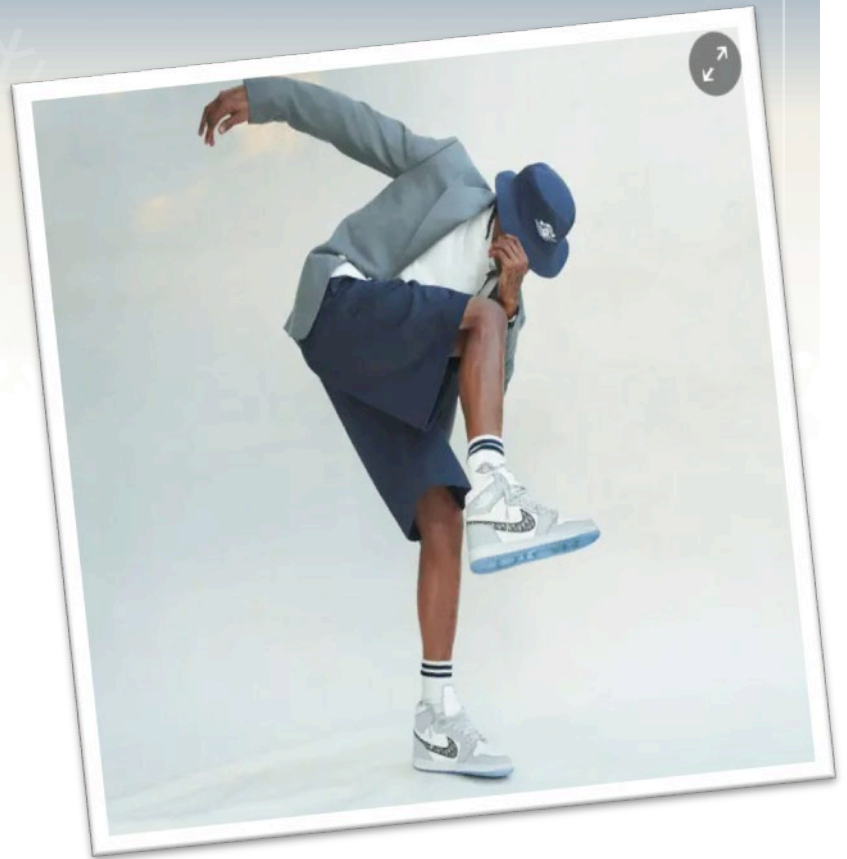
May I rejoice in your glorious victory, may I praise your majestic name.
